

2016-17 Yell Leader Junior Yell position:

- Must be a current full-time student at Texas A&M University as well as be in good standing with the university.
- Must have posted at least a 2.0 GPA in the Fall 2015 semester and have at least a 2.25 cumulative GPA.
- Must not be on any kind of conduct probation with the University.
- Must be classified as a senior according to at least one of the following definitions:
 - o originally entered the university in the summer or fall semester of 2014
 - o cadet class and rank (Corps of Cadets only)
 - o successfully completed hours as determined by the University Registrar (transfer students only)

Purpose of the Yell Leaders

- To represent the University at athletic events by leading organized yells, encouraging the student body to support the team(s), and assisting and encouraging sportsmanship by the student body.
- To organize and conduct yell practices on an "as needed" basis.
- To promote the University and its traditions by speaking to and educating new students, transfer students, and prospective students, former students, and other organizations and associates of the University.
- To represent the University in meetings and associations with other universities in respect to the organization and conduct of Texas A&M students at athletic events.
- To function as a liaison between the Texas A&M Athletic Department, Texas A&M athletic teams, and the student body.
- To perform other tasks and duties as they arise that are otherwise consistent with the aforementioned objects and purposes.

Expectations of the Yell Leaders

- Consistently represent Texas A&M University positively while upholding the core values of TAMU
- Be successful in your academic pursuits while performing the functions of yell leader
- Be available for functions, appearances and athletic events beginning in March 2016 following elections through May 2017
- Travel to various Aggie Mom's Clubs, Fish Camp, and Coach's Nights over the summer months
- Attend regular meetings with the Yell Leader advisors
- Attend student organization leader training as outlined for sponsored student organizations
- Be present at ALL events that are assigned.

Time Commitments

- The yell leader role begins the day you are elected into the position and does not end until May 2017
- There are weekly events for the yell leaders, and some weeks there are daily events.
- Beginning in April there will be weekly yell leader meetings
- You will be expected to attend multiple trainings throughout the year
- June, July and August are heavy travel months for the yell leaders
- The yell leader role is very time consuming.
