



# Residential Housing ASSOCIATION

By decree of the Residential Housing Association (RHA), pertaining to the Texas A&M University elections of all student placeholders, let these policies be held adamantly. All candidates who wish to campaign in the residence halls in any way take notice of these guidelines, as violations will result in penalties of various degrees.

Fliers are allowed to be passed out by the Resident Advisor Staff and will be taken care of once brought to location

Campaign fliers must include all of the following:

- Contact name
- Contact information
- Date of Removal - after elections
- Clear information about the candidate and the position to which they are running
- Appropriate Content
- Follows Election guidelines
- Upholds the Aggie Core values

Fliers must be brought to the South Area Office (Commons 127) or North Area Office (Hullabaloo 101) **as as soon as possible** to provide adequate time for the Reslife staff to hang up around the hall.

Fliers must be printed by the candidate and bundled in accordance to the area of campus to which they are going:

Southside fliers: 65 fliers

Northside fliers: 95 fliers

Any additional fliers that are not brought through the North Area Office or South Area Office will be deemed in violation of the Residential Housing Association Guidelines for campaigning and will be brought to the Election Commissioner.
